CVFRS has immediate openings for two permanent part time positions at the AEMT or Paramedic Crew Chief level. These are 24 hours per week (two 12 hour shifts) positions. You will be required to serve as a primary provider for our 911 ambulance, leading AEMT's/Paramedics on 911 responses in the Town of Charlotte and surrounding communities. Administrative duties will include, but are not limited to, assisting volunteers and per diem staff with ongoing training, as well as apparatus and equipment maintenance. QUALIFICATIONS

- A valid AEMT/Paramedic Certification
- Valid Driver's License
- Minimum 2 years experience in a 911 EMS system, 3 years preferred
- Minimum 1 year experience in a 911 EMS System as a Crew Chief or independent provider
- Knowledge about current EMS issues on local/state/national level
- Ability to make quick, well-educated decisions
- Excellent communication skills
- Excellent organizational skills
- Excellent past work record and pass a background/ driver's license check

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Provide high quality prehospital care and leadership
- Direct ALL aspects of the scene and crew present in the management of emergency scenes, including requests for mutual aid
- Provide mentoring/training to crew members
- Perform station duties, to include answering the phone, greeting visitors and station upkeep
- Perform vehicle and equipment maintenance
- Participate in the QA/QI process including, but not limited to review of ePCR's
- Provide updates to oncoming shift leader
